GODLY ENDURANCE

If the Bible feels intimidating, you are not alone. The goal is not to become an expert overnight. The goal is to come to God honestly, open His Word, and take one faithful next step.

1

PRAY

Ask God to help you understand, receive, and obey His Word. Keep it simple: Lord, help me see what You want me to see.

2

READ

Choose a small passage and read slowly. One paragraph is enough when you are beginning or returning.

3

NOTICE

Look for repeated words, commands, promises, warnings, questions, and anything that reveals God's character.

4

RESPOND

Turn the passage into prayer, confession, surrender, gratitude, or one practical act of obedience.

SIMPLE GOAL

Read prayerfully. Come with humility, curiosity, and a willingness to respond to what God shows you.

REMEMBER

- Questions are allowed.
- You do not have to understand everything at once.
- Start with Jesus and keep returning.

BIBLE START GUIDE

where to begin

GODLY ENDURANCE

If you do not know where to start, choose a clear path instead of opening randomly every day. These books and passages give you strong entry points.

JOHN

Begin here to see who Jesus is, why He came, and how He invites people to believe and receive life.

MARK

A fast-moving Gospel that shows Jesus in action. Notice His authority, compassion, urgency, and call to follow.

ACTS

Shows how the Holy Spirit empowered ordinary believers and how the gospel moved outward with courage.

PSALMS

Honest prayers for fear, grief, worship, repentance, trust, and learning to bring your real heart to God.

PROVERBS

Wisdom for everyday choices, words, discipline, relationships, humility, and the fear of the Lord.

ROMANS 8

A powerful chapter for identity, freedom from condemnation, suffering, hope, and life in the Spirit.

BEST FIRST PLACE

Start with the Gospel of John if you want one clear beginning. Read slowly and notice what Jesus says about Himself.

After you spend time in a Gospel, these New Testament letters are helpful for learning what it looks like to follow Jesus in real life.

EPHESIANS

Shows who you are in Christ, what grace has done, and how faith reshapes relationships, unity, spiritual warfare, and everyday obedience.

GALATIANS

Helps you understand freedom in Christ, why you cannot earn salvation, and what it means to walk by the Spirit instead of the flesh.

PHILIPPIANS

Teaches joy, humility, endurance, prayer, contentment, and keeping your mind fixed on Christ even in hardship.

JAMES

Very practical. It connects faith to speech, patience, wisdom, temptation, humility, and actually doing the Word.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR

Ask what the passage reveals about God, your heart, and one clear step of faithfulness.

WHEN IT FEELS HARD

- Read the surrounding verses.
- Ask who is speaking and who is listening.
- Obey what is clear while you keep learning.
